pre-test setup

- prelim. (non-public) Preliminary tests of every tabulator & VAT
 - results deck Test deck of expected results
 - mutually exclusive unique tally for each option
 - "test" ballots all ballots are marked "test"
 - elections all election options on ballot (inc. write-in)
 - seal #s test cert. forms & ballot container
 - container Approved ballot container
 - zero report paper & screen show zero ballots
 - open polls code accepted, tabulator ready

tabulator:ballot tests

- wrong precinct rejects without option
 - blank rejects, with options
 - overvote rejects, with options
 - undervote rejects, with options
 - stray marks scans
 - creased scans (e.g. mail-in ballot)

post-test

- close polls code accepted, scan disabled
 - report shows expected results per test deck
 - transmit connects & completes transmission
 - zero count tabulator count re-zero'd
 - seal #s seal numbers recorded on certificate

optional tests

- re-run 2nd scan of same ballot doesn't tabulate
 - upside down scans regardless of orientation
 - backwards "
